**ORDINANCE NO. 271**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 198 AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOVEMENT OF SNOW INTO STREETS, ALLEYS, PUBLIC WAY OR BOULEVARD ADJACENT TO ANY OTHER PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIDGERWOOD, RICHLAND COUNTY, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

It is an offense against the ordinances of the City of Lidgerwood for any individual, business, firm or corporation owning or occupying or using any private property in the City of Lidgerwood to haul, shovel, blow, dump or otherwise deposit any snow which is accumulated or located on private property on or into any street, alley or public way in the City of Lidgerwood, unless other arrangements have been made with the City.

No person owning or occupying or using any private property in the city shall haul, move into, or dump on any street, alley or public way in the city, any snow which is accumulated or located on such private property. No person shall cause snow being removed from private property to be placed upon the property of another, nor shall any person cause snow being removed from private property to be placed upon the boulevard adjacent to any other property.

Each individual occurrence is an infraction for which a fine as set by resolution will be imposed along with assessment of all costs incurred by the City for clean-up.

Effective date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of the first snow fall of the winter 2020 to 2021.

Motion by Erickson to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance 272 Amending Ordinance 206, Section 3 Time to License Dogs second by Medenwald with all in favor and none nay.

**ORDINANCE No. 272**

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 206, SECTIONS 3.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIDGERWOOD, RICHLAND COUNTY, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA THAT ORDINANCE NO. 206, SECTION 3 SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3. TIME TO LICENSE DOGS.

Dog licenses shall be secured immediately after January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and shall be in force from and after the date of procurement until the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January thereafter, when a new license must be paid for and secured. If license is not obtained by February 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, a late penalty fee as set by resolution will be added to the license fee.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of January 1, 2021.

Motion by Storbakken to hire Evan Grenz and Nancy Boudreau to work the dump with Evan being lead and Nancy as back up second by Dylan with all in favor and none nay.

Motion by Erickson to pay \$14.00 an hour for the dump employees second by Storbakken with all in favor and none nay.

Discussion was had about the City Wide Clean Up, for now it will be postponed indefinitely.

Motion by Storbakken to adjourn meeting at 8:28 pm seconded by Medenwald with all in favor and none nay.
