RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR PAST DUE DOG LICENSE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood, pursuant to Ordinance 272 of the ordinances of the City of Lidgerwood provides that the City Council may establish charges for past due dog license in the City of Lidgerwood by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood has reviewed the existing late penalty fee procedures and charges to the City residents with dogs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood, Richland County, North Dakota as follows:

A dog license which is not paid for by February 1, of each year will be charged \$30.00 for each past due dog license.

Be it further resolved that the effective date of this Resolution is January 01, 2021.

RESOLUTION NO. 359

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES FOR PROHIBITING MOVEMENT OF SNOW INTO STREETS, ALLEYS, PUBLIC WAY OR BOULEVARD ADJACENT TO ANY OTHER PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood, pursuant to Ordinance 271 of the ordinances of the City of Lidgerwood provides that the City Council may establish fines for snow moved into streets, alleys, public way or boulevard adjacent to any other property in the City of Lidgerwood by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood has reviewed the existing fines to the City's residents for snow moved into streets, alleys, public way or boulevard adjacent to any other property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lidgerwood, Richland County, North Dakota as follows:

The fine for snow moved into streets, alleys, public way or boulevard adjacent to any other property will be:

First Offense will be a warning.

Second and Any Future Offenses will be a \$500.00 fine

Be it further resolved that the effective date of this Resolution is January 1, 2021.

Motion by Storbakken to give Lonny and Donna Medenwaldt the building permit for the garage second by Medenwald with all in favor and none nay.

Motion by Irwin to approve the Backyard Chicken Permit for Brian and April Baldwin with all in favor and none nay.

Motion by Medenwald to give Jason Forster a Backyard Chicken Permit second by Irwin with all in favor and none nay.

Motion by Storbakken to designate the News Monitor as the official paper of the City of Lidgerwood second by Medenwald with all in favor and none nay.

Discussion was had about transient merchant ordinances or resolutions. There will be information gathered and discussion at another council meeting.
